- b. State Interoperability Governing Body (SIGB). At the August meeting, Mr. Rockwell briefed the Governor's Administrative Order 333 had created the 9-1-1 governing body to look at all things regarding interoperable public safety communications, but he did not expect anything from them for the next six to eight months.
- c. Long-term Cost Share Solution. At the August meeting, Mr. Rockwell stated they were still working with the Governor's Chief of Staff to develop a long-term funding solution, because capital requests are more difficult to obtain.

- d. DOD Contract for System Upgrade. At the August meeting, Mr. Timothy Woodall stated that all the Department of Defense (DOD) services had their funding, but the transportable units were not funded and will not get funded this year and Mr. Scott Stormo noted the State had gotten the task order added on the contract. (CLOSED)
- e. DOD FY22 Budget Status. At the August meeting, Colonel Meerstein stated the Federal government had moved from a continuing resolution to signing into law the Defense Authorization Act, and so funds have been dispersed. **(CLOSED)**
- f. Fiduciary Responsibility Documentation. At the August meeting, Mr. Woodall stated Reservist attorney Major Lancaster was working on the document when she was last there and she will be coming back for reservist duty and hopefully she will have a shell to begin working with the State of Alaska and the other federal DOD entities to fill in the process, the procedures, and the stakeholders that would be involved/affected.
- g. FY24 OMO/SMO Budget. At the August meeting, Mr. Nelson explained the OMO would normally be providing the FY24 Budget to the council at this time but were still waiting on cost projections and infrastructure replacement information.
