Alaska Land Mobile Radio Subscriber Acceptance Testing Policy

1. Applicability

This policy applies to all employees, contractors, subcontractors, consultants, temporary employees, and to any/all P25-compliant, manufacturers/vendors requesting approval for their radios to operate on the Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) Communications System. Any substantial revision or update of this policy must be approved by the User Council.

2. Policy

Prior to approval to operate on the ALMR system, all manufacturer/vendor radios must pass an ALMR Acceptance Test Procedure (ATP) against specified protocols of the standardized test designed to meet the needs/requirements of our system users. Approval to operate on the system should not be construed as any type of manufacturer/vendor radio certification.

3. Procedures


Manufacturers producing P25-compliant, TDMA-capable radios may provide their equipment for ATP testing on ALMR at any time by contacting the ALMR Operations Management Office (OMO) or the System Management Office (SMO) to schedule a test date.

The ATP will be conducted by the SMO and the authorized manufacturer/vendor agent. A member of the OMO shall be present during the testing for quality assurance/quality control.

Results of the test shall be provided to the OMO at the conclusion of the test, whether the subscriber passes or not.

4. Effective Date

This policy shall become effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until rescinded. The policy shall be reviewed periodically and updated, as required.
