



## **Alaska Land Mobile Radio Technology Policy**

### **1. Applicability**

This policy applies to all employees, contractors, subcontractors, consultants, temporary employees, and other personnel assigned to the Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) Communications System Operations Management Office (OMO) and System Management Office (SMO). Any substantial revision or update of this policy must be approved by the User Council.

### **2. Policy**

The OMO and SMO are committed to improving communications and advancing the technologies employed within the ALMR System for the benefit of stakeholders and the agencies that utilize it. The OMO will constantly monitor and review information regarding ALMR and supporting technologies and provide pertinent information to member agencies and the User Council (UC) for their consideration.


### **3. Procedures**

Member agencies with operational needs not currently supported by ALMR, who become aware of a technology advancement that may increase or improve system capabilities to meet those requirements, may request the OMO/SMO conduct research on the applicable technology in accordance with the instructions set out in ALMR Technology Procedure 300-2.

The OMO will conduct the appropriate research and will provide the results to the requesting member agency and the UC.

### **4. Effective Date**

This policy shall become effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until rescinded. The policy shall be reviewed periodically and updated, as required.
