



## **Alaska Land Mobile Radio System Backup and Recovery Policy**

### **1. Applicability**

This policy applies to all employees, contractors, subcontractors, consultants, temporary employees, and other personnel assigned to support the Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) Communications System. This policy describes the basis for appropriate backup and recovery procedures for the ALMR system as specified in DODI 8500.2. Any substantial revision or update of this policy must be approved by the User Council.

### **2. Policy**

The System Management Office shall coordinate and oversee all backup and recovery operations and ensure they are performed in accordance with the ALMR System Backup and Recovery Procedure 400-5.


These operations shall meet or surpass the minimum accepted level of backup and recovery for all ALMR systems in the form of technical, operational, and managerial control as required by NIST SP800-53r5, *Security and Privacy controls for Information Systems and Organizations*.

### **3. Procedures**

The SMO shall perform periodic backups of the ALMR system to enable the controlled recovery in the event of a disaster, either manmade or natural. The established controls and procedures shall minimize the impact on system users and ensure an expeditious return to operations.

### **4. Effective Date**

This policy shall become effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until rescinded. The policy shall be reviewed periodically and updated, as required.
