**Alaska Land Mobile Radio
Key Management Facility Policy**

1. Applicability

This policy applies to the Alaska Land Mobile Radio (ALMR) Communications System, member agencies, all employees, contractors, sub-contractors, consultants, vendors, temporary employees, and any other individuals who utilize the ALMR system. Any substantial revision or update of this policy must be approved by the User Council.

2. Policy

As the primary maintainer of the ALMR system, the System Management Office (SMO) has overall authority regarding Key Management Facilities (KMFs).

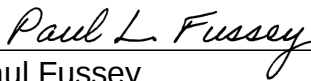
3. Procedures

The SMO will maintain, track, and assign all Common Key Reference (CKR) numbers, as well as maintain the list of locations of all KMFs associated with the ALMR system.

Agencies owning/operating one or more KMFs will utilize the prescribed naming conventions, as well as the methods and processes for distribution of cryptographic key material to radio and infrastructure devices in a P25 multi-zoned, trunked two-way radio system as outlined in Key Management Facility Procedure 400-17.

4. Effective Date

This policy shall become effective upon signature and shall remain in effect until rescinded. The policy shall be reviewed periodically and updated, as required.
